

Did you know-- if you have some non-tennis fans going they can enjoy:

At 1,255 acres, Flushing Meadows Corona Park is one and a half times the size of Manhattan's Central Park.

The park is so big that it plays host to the <u>New York Mets at Shea Stadium</u> and <u>US Open Tennis</u>, as well as to hundreds, even thousands, of visitors who come for weekend picnics, strolls, festivals, soccer games, and other activities. There are two lakes, a pitch-and-putt golf course (miniature golf), playing fields, picnic areas, and bicycle rental stands (more on <u>park activities</u>).

The Park is home to the <u>Queens Museum of Art</u> (and its amazing diorama of NYC's five boroughs), the <u>New York Hall of</u> <u>Science</u> (an interactive science learning center), the <u>Queens Zoo</u>, the <u>Queens Theatre in the Park</u>, and the <u>Queens</u> <u>Botanical Garden</u>. The park hosts several annual festivals, including the Colombian Independence Day Celebration (one of the largest Latino events in NYC) and the Dragon Boat Festival.

The World's Fair was held in Flushing Meadows Park twice: in 1939-40 and again in 1964-65. Two towers from the 1964-65 World's Fair -- also featured in Men in Black -- still dominate the area's skyline, though they are in a sorry state. Other facilities from the fairs include the NYC Building (housing the museum and an ice rink), the Unisphere, and numerous statues and monuments.
